Lanterns are floated onto the river to comfort the souls of those lost to the atomic bombing and war, and to pray for everlasting world peace.

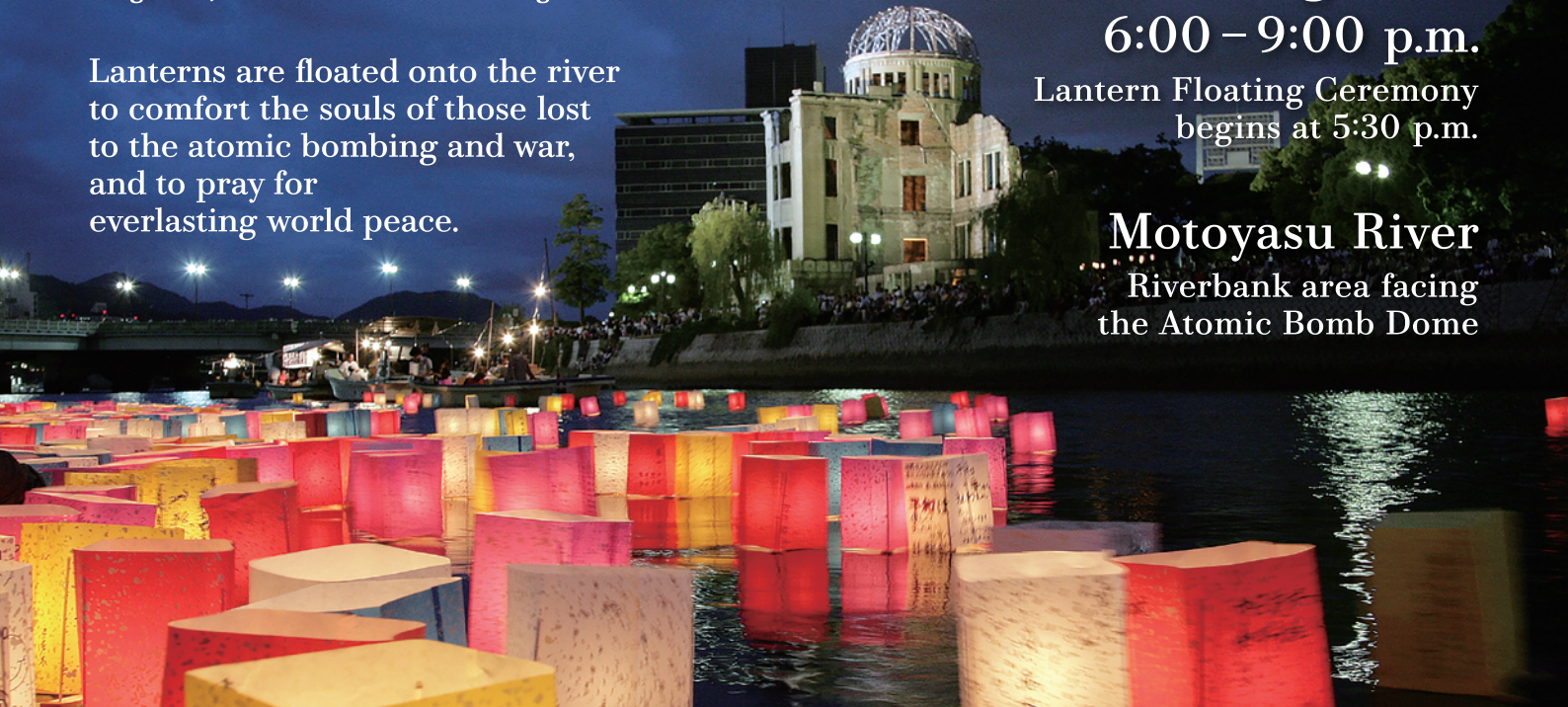

Riverbank area facing the Atomic Bomb Dome

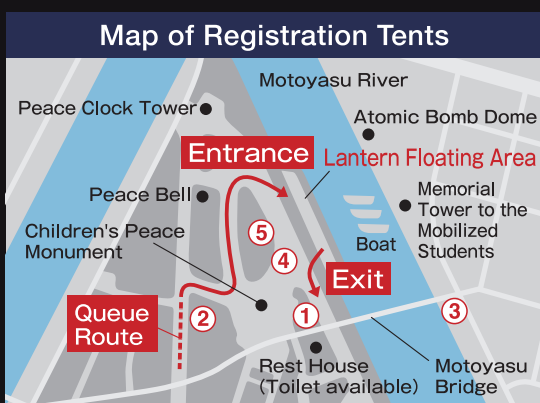


## Join us to float lanterns.
